Pointe Est School, Haiti Sponsorship Program

In Haiti, children begin school at age three and continue until they are 19 years old or older. All Haitian schools charge tuition. If a child does not have the money to pay tuition, he/she must drop out and return only when finances are available.

Without this help, most of these children would not get an education, and would live illiterate, as most of Haiti's population. Without an education their future is limited. This is one reason we hope you will consider a sponsorship each year.

Sponsors often ask about communicating with their child. Because of the language barrier (Creole is the native language of the Haitian People), no mail delivery, the remoteness of this village, and the overall lack of facilities and money, it is nearly impossible to have an ongoing correspondence between you and your child.
